As outlined in *The Electoral Roll (Availability) Rules, 2020*, an electronic copy of the full Electoral Roll will be made available to candidates from the date they deliver their nomination form to the Presiding Officer (the Bailiff), provided they have registered as a Data Controller, as set out below.

Candidates are also able to purchase up to two additional hard copies of the Electoral Roll for each parish, and two hard copies of each parish in Road Order (Walk Order).

How do I access free electronic canvassing materials?

Digital copies of the following documents will be available to all candidates for free on www.election2020.gg.

- Electoral Roll (Excel version, all parishes)
- Walk Order map with lines suggesting walk order (PDF by parish)
- Walk Order map without lines (PDF by parish)
- Electoral Roll Walk order (PDF by parish)
- Relevant Candidate Forms

Steps on how to access your free digital materials

- Register online with the <u>Office of the Data Protection Authority (ODPA)</u> (see Instructions for Registering as a Controller leaflet on how to register)
- Submit your candidate nomination form to the Presiding Officer (Bailiff) at the Bailiff's Chambers, Royal Court building, between 9am and 4pm, 1st - 4th September
- 3. Follow signs to 'Electoral Roll Collection' room in the Royal Court Building, with your proof of ODPA registration, and **collect your instructions on how to access** the digital materials

<u>IMPORTANT</u>: Digital Access will only be granted to individuals who have submitted their nomination form, and have registered with the ODPA.

How do I order printed canvassing materials?

Candidates may also pre-order printed copies of the following documents at a cost. Details of costs are listed on page 5;

- Electoral Roll Alphabetical (by parish)
- Walk Order Maps with lines suggesting walk order (by parish)
- Walk Order Maps without lines (by parish)
- Electoral Roll Walk order (by parish)

Steps on how to order your printed materials

- 1. Register online with the Office of the Data Protection Authority (ODPA)
- 2. Complete the overleaf *Printed Materials Pre-Order Form*, and return it by **24**th **August to ensure you order will be ready for collection on time.**
- 3. Submit your candidate nomination form to the Presiding Officer (the Bailiff), Bailiff's Chambers, Royal Court building, between 9am and 4pm, 1st 4th September
- 4. Pay for your printed materials by card at the Greffe public counter 1st- 4th September and follow signs to the 'Electoral Roll Collection' room, with your proof of ODPA registration and your payment receipt, and collect your pre-ordered materials

<u>IMPORTANT</u>: Demand is likely to be high and you are therefore advised to order additional material as soon as possible. Whilst we will process all requests as quickly as we can, please note that we cannot guarantee that orders will be received before the nominations period closes.

Data protection

Electoral Roll materials will only be made available to those candidates who have registered as a Controller with the Office of the Data Protection Authority. For information on how to become a Data Controller, please refer to section 6 of the *Guidance for Candidates* booklet and the separate leaflet *Instructions on How to Register as a Controller*.

Candidates may print their own copies of the Electoral Roll from the digital files for the purpose of election campaigning. On completion of election campaigning, that is after the election (8th October 2020), all digital and printed copies of the Electoral Roll must be destroyed.

Payment of printed materials

Location: Greffe Public Counter, 1st floor Royal Court building, St James Street, St Peter Port

Dates: Monday – Friday 9am-4pm from 1st September onwards

Payment: Card payment must be made prior to collecting your materials. Payment can be made;

Over the phone: Telephone Client Services, Monday- Friday 9am- 4pm 01481 725 277 ready with your total to pay, and your card details. A receipt will be emailed to you upon payment. Bring this receipt to collect your materials.

In person at the Greffe public counter 1st floor Royal Court

Please retain your payment receipt, as this will be required to collect your materials.
